COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS – DECEMBER 20, 2011

- A three-year agreement for administrative services (2012-2014) with Flagstaff County was approved.
- The preliminary 2012 budget was approved. Although the mill rates will not be confirmed until next Spring, the average change proposed for the municipal portion only see a reduction of 1.1%.
- The 'Fire Services Agreement' with Flagstaff County expired at the end of 2011, and council approved a one-year extension with any changes being retroactive to January 1, 2012.
