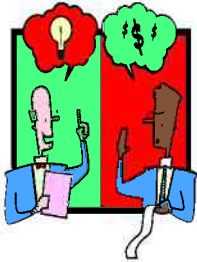

**Notice of Public Hearing**

to Amend Land Use Bylaw 01-09

In accordance with the requirements of Section 692(1) of the Municipal Government Act S.A.2000 the Village of Galahad gives notice that it has given first reading to bylaw 05-11 to amend land use bylaw 01-09.

The purpose of bylaw 05-11 is:

1. Land Use District Map, of Land Use Bylaw 01-09 is amended through a Land Use Designation Change on the south west side of Guinevere (Railway) Avenue:
  - Plan 0622563; Area A (Substation Site) containing 0.021 hectares (0.052 acres) more or less excepting thereout all mines and minerals; and
  - Descriptive Plan 0023605; Block A; Lot 1 excepting thereout A) Plan 0622563, right of way (Substation Site) 0.021 hectares (0.052 acres) more or less excepting thereout all mines and minerals.
2. Amendment to Land Use Bylaw 01-09 to effect the change in land use district as described in 1.

A Public Hearing with respect to this bylaw amendment will be held May 10, 2011 1:15 p.m. in the Village office, 312 Merlin Street, Galahad, Alberta.

Persons wishing to make representation to the Council on this matter are requested to advise the undersigned no later than 12 Noon on May 9th, 2011. Written submissions and those persons who have advised of their wish to speak will be heard first, and other submission will be heard

following.

The proposed bylaw and other related documents such as a land use map may be inspected in the Galahad village office in the Flagstaff County building in Sedgewick, Alberta during regular business hours (8:30 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.) or in Galahad village office in Galahad, (Tuesdays 9 – 4 pm).

The purpose of Bylaw 05-11 is to zone Village-owned property between Guinevere Avenue and the rail line to "light industrial". Currently, this land has no designation, and the bylaw amendment is intended to correct this oversight.
