## COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS – OCTOBER 18, 2011

- Organizational meeting for Village Council was held October 18, 2011. The following positions were declared, by acclamation for another year term:  
Mayor Sheryl Fossen and Deputy Mayor Jeanette Herle.
- An official Deputy Director of Disaster Services is required to work with Clr. Jeanette Herle – (see notice on back page of newsletter). If you could commit to some time in this area, please talk to Jeanette, or contact the Office.
- Council approved policy and user guidelines to permit approved companies to dump septic waste in the municipal sanitary sewer system, in accordance with Alberta Environment guidelines.
- Council approved an initiative for community paper recycling proposed by Flagstaff Waste Management at a per capita cost of \$1 annually.

tage of dollar parity and lower US prices!!!

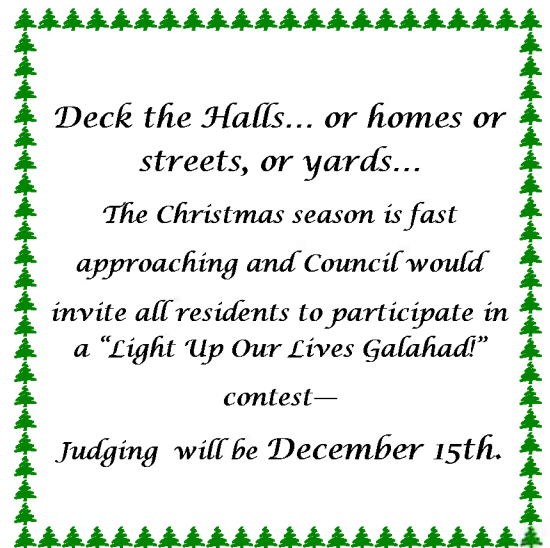
Price: \$300 per person, based on double occupancy (other occu-
