COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS – SEPTEMBER 20, 2011

- *Following discussions with DGE Group Inc. the following infrastructure priorities were approved:*
 - *Improvements to drainage in the areas of King Arthur & Lady Vivian Street East*
 - *Surface investigation to complete assessment & recommendations for east end of Guinevere Avenue East*
 - *Assessment/inspection of underground water/wastewater lines*
- *The following projects will be submitted for project approval under the Municipal Sustainability Initiatives capital grant funding:*
 - *Well house replacement*
 - *Municipal Building (School) roof rehabilitation*
- *A draft policy was accepted in principle 'to set procedures for companies to permit dumping of septic wastes into the Village sanitary sewer system'. The final draft policy will be presented for approval at the October 2011 meeting. A per dump fee of \$25 was approved for septic disposal companies.*
- *Leslie Heck, Coordinator for Flagstaff Intermunicipal Partnership gave an update on the future initiatives for this group, as well as a recap of past accomplishments. Council approved the 2012 & 2013 (est.) operating budgets for this group – funding for which will be requisitioned from participating municipalities.*

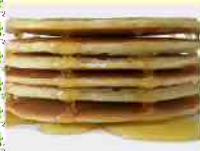

Excerpts from "Traffic Bylaw" 4/87 - Village of Galahad

Unless required or permitted by the Highway Traffic Act...a driver shall not stop or park his/her vehicle:

- *On a sidewalk or boulevard*
- *At an intersection nearer than 5 meters to the projection of the corner property line immediately ahead or immediately to the rear ...*
- *Within 5 meters on the approach to a stop sign or yield sign*
- *Within 1.5 meters of an access to a garage, private road or driveway, or a vehicle crosswalk over a sidewalk*

No person shall park a trailer on any highway (street) unless the trailer is attached to the motor vehicle used for towing the vehicle.

Bylaw 01-10 Unsightly

Unsightly and/or untidy premises' means a property or part of it that is detrimental to the surrounding area pursuant to the MGA,s. 546 as characterized by visual or sensory evidence of a lack of general maintenance and upkeep, or causing a decline in the market value of property in the area: including, but not limited to:

1. The whole or part of any motor vehicle as defined in the Traffic Safety Act, RAS200, as amended or repealed and replaced from time to time, or farm implement.
2. That is in a rusted, wrecked, partly wrecked, dismantled, partly dismantled, or inoperative condition, and is not located in a building or located on the property such that it can be concealed from view; or
3. That has no current license plate attached to it and in respect of which, no registration certificate has been issued for the current year; and
4. That is inoperative by reason of removed parts or equipment, and is not located within a building or located on property such that it can be concealed from view.
